## About Brainkind Jane Percy House

Brainkind Jane Percy House offers specialist, person-centred care and support for people with complex and high-dependency needs. Located in Cramlington, Northumberland and built around a sunny private garden and courtyard, we help the people we support to live as independently as possible and offer short term or long-term care for those who need it.

We focus on enabling people to function more independently and develop their lives as they choose. For example, our in-house activities coordinator works with the people we support to create engaging, meaningful activities based on their interests and needs.

Brainkind Jane Percy House, rated 'Outstanding' by the CQC, is equipped with a wide range of facilities to help support the delivery of our expert care. Our support team works with community physiotherapists, speech and language therapists, and occupational therapists. The people we support also have access to accessible exercise equipment, a sensory room and garden, and a cardio wall.

Whether someone needs assistance with daily tasks, help to improve emotional or social skills, or support with their physical wellbeing, our services ensure that life after a brain injury or with complex neurological conditions is a life well lived – whatever that means to the people we support.

We also have strong connections with local church groups and charities – making Jane Percy House ideal for community integration – as well as a wheelchair-accessible vehicle on-site.

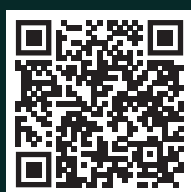
## Conditions we specialise in

We support people with disabilities including cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy, spina bifida, arthritis, multiple sclerosis, and conditions resulting from accidents or a stroke.

We also support people with acquired brain injuries or complex neurological conditions who are experiencing one or more of the following:

- Cognitive problems including thinking, memory, problem-solving, learning, awareness, and perception
- Physical impairments that affect mobility, posture, or dexterity
- Communication difficulties
- Behaviours that challenge
