Brainkind Kent House is a specialist residential home for people with acquired brain injuries in Aylesbury, Buckinghamshire. We provide long-term, person-centred care to enable the people we support to live as independently as possible in an environment that enhances their wellbeing.

About Brainkind Kent House

Brainkind Kent House is a **specialist residential home** offering long-term residential care and support for people with acquired brain injuries or complex neurological conditions who need ongoing support to maintain their independence.

We focus on improving quality of life for the people we support. Our programmes include personalised activities, guided leisure time, and therapeutic sessions.

Brainkind Kent House, **rated 'Good' by the CQC**, is equipped with a wide range of facilities to help support the delivery of our expert care. The people we support have access to outstanding therapeutic and recreational facilities in their rehabilitation and recovery.

The people we support are actively involved in reviewing their progress. We promote the **active involvement of families** in the care of their loved ones and home leave is encouraged wherever possible.

Whether someone needs assistance with daily tasks, help to improve emotional or social skills, or support to regain their physical independence, our services ensure that life after a brain injury is a **life well lived** – whatever that means to the people we support.





Overview

- Sixteen single bedrooms, each with a bathroom.
- Four separate bungalows, each with a bedroom, bathroom, and kitchen. The people we support are encouraged to personalise their bedrooms to make them feel more at home.
- A one-bedroom supported living flat.
- Spacious and well-appointed communal areas for dining and relaxation complement individual accommodation.
- Rehabilitation occurs in a tranquil and supportive environment.
- The people we support have access to a wide range of therapeutic and recreational facilities, including a therapy room, sensory room, and adapted kitchen.
- A large private garden.

Becoming more independent

Access to the community is integral to rehabilitation. Brainkind Kent House is located in the busy town of Aylesbury, offering a wide range of educational and vocational opportunities, making it ideal for social integration. The people we support also have easy access to local shops and leisure facilities, including the Stoke Mandeville sports stadium.

More support

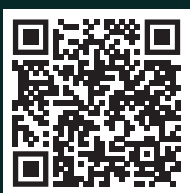
Brainkind Kent House has a one-bedroom supported living flat and four bungalows where the people we support can strengthen their skills before moving on to a more independent environment.

Conditions we specialise in

We provide support for and specialise in the rehabilitation of people with brain injuries and neurological conditions who are experiencing one or more of the following:

- Cognitive problems including thinking, memory, problem-solving, learning, awareness, and perception
- Physical impairments that affect mobility, posture, or dexterity
- Physical and verbal aggression
- Disinhibited and / or impulsive behaviour
