

Neurological centre **Kerwin Court**



Brainkind Kerwin Court is a neurological centre in Horsham, West Sussex providing innovative rehabilitation and person-centred support to enable people to thrive after a brain injury. We provide an environment that enhances wellbeing and ensures that the people we support can live as independently as possible.

About Kerwin Court

Brainkind Kerwin Court is a specialist neurological centre where people with acquired brain injuries or complex neurological conditions come for assessment and rehabilitation.

Brainkind Kerwin Court is equipped with a wide range of facilities to help support the delivery of our expert treatment and care.

Our specialist rehabilitation is based on a neurobehavioural approach. This is the idea that rehabilitation is community based and delivered 24/7 through Rehabilitation Support Workers.

Kerwin Court has a multidisciplinary team including a clinical psychologist, occupational therapists, physiotherapists and speech and language therapists. We focus on enabling people to function more independently and live their lives as they choose.

Our personalised structured programmes include educational and therapeutic sessions; group therapy sessions; support for personal, social, and domestic skills; guided leisure time; vocational support and training; and access to the local community.

The people we support are actively involved in reviewing their progress. We promote the involvement of families in the rehabilitation process, and home leave is encouraged and supported wherever possible.

Whether someone needs assistance with daily tasks, help to improve emotional wellbeing or social skills, or support to regain their physical independence, our services ensure that life after a brain injury is a life well lived – whatever that means to each person we support.



Service overview and facilities

- 16 bedrooms, with level access ensuite bathrooms.
- Two self-contained flats to allow people to practise developing independent living skills, with the support of our specialist rehabilitation support workers.
- Five self-contained bungalows just outside the main building. These support a further step towards greater independence but with prompt, 24/7 access to staff.
- A spacious communal lounge, games room, dining area, and smaller quiet spaces where families and friends can meet.
- Two kitchens and two laundry rooms where people can practise daily living skills with staff support.
- Several therapy rooms and a gym.
- A dedicated area for therapeutic gardening with raised beds, a polytunnel, and covered gazebo.

Becoming more independent

Access to the wider community is integral to rehabilitation. Located near the West Sussex town of Horsham, with a wide range of shops and leisure facilities, Brainkind Kerwin Court is well situated for social interaction and offers opportunities for education and volunteering.

Slow-stream beds

We also offer slow-stream beds, designed for people who need more time and a gentler pace to achieve their goals. This service combines the same high standards of care and therapy as our fast-stream programmes, but with extended timelines and personalised activity plans that place quality of life at the forefront.

Each person benefits from:

- Flexible clinical add-ins tailored to their needs as/if required
- A rich programme of therapeutic activities and guided leisure time
- Opportunities to develop personal, social, and domestic skills at their own pace
- Full participation in our welcoming community and access to local amenities

Our slow-stream approach is ideal for individuals progressing from acute rehabilitation, or for those whose recovery is best supported by a steady, sustainable pathway.

More support

Brainkind Kerwin Court also contains two flats and five bungalows within the grounds where the people we support can develop their skills before moving home or on to a more independent environment.

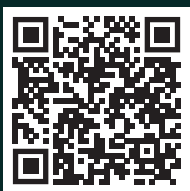
Conditions we specialise in

We provide support for and specialise in the rehabilitation of people with brain injuries and other neurological conditions, who are experiencing one or more of the following:

- Cognitive problems including difficulties with processing information, memory, problem solving, learning, reduced self awareness, and perception
- Physical impairments that affect mobility, balance, posture, or dexterity
- Difficulties regulating behaviour, such as impulsivity, disinhibition, or agitation
- Communications difficulties and with community participation and integration
